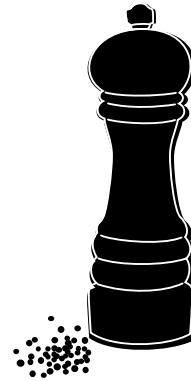
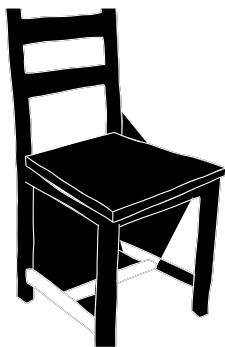


Some musical instruments are made from rainforest wood



Spices like pepper are sold in the supermarket



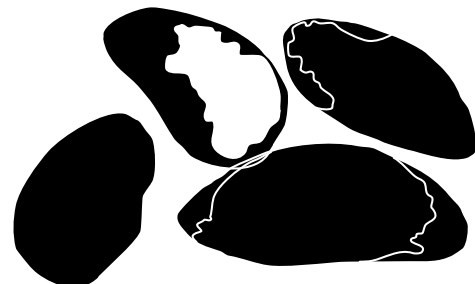
Some furniture is made from rainforest wood

The rainforest provides gums and resins used in many products we use



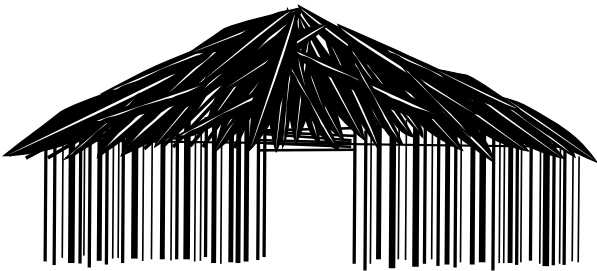
Fruits, nuts and honey from the rainforest are good to eat



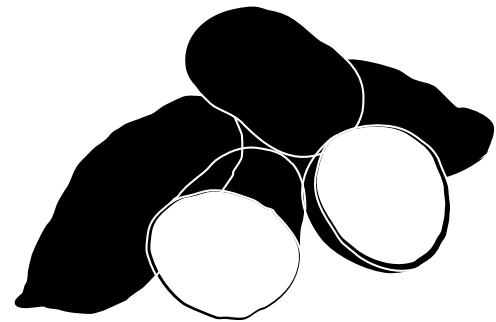
Some rainforest plants are good medicines



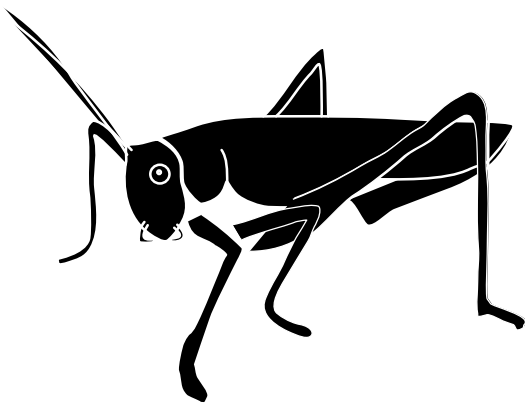
Wood is collected as fuel for warmth and cooking



Tree branches and leaves are used for making rainforest homes



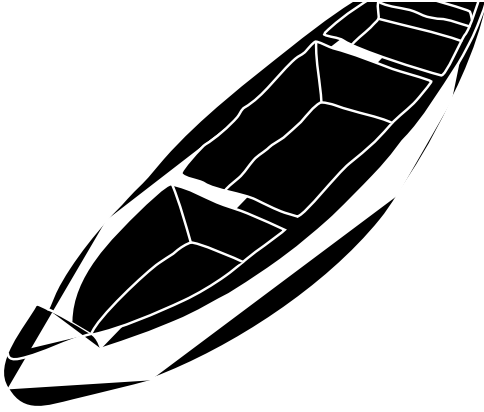
Farmers grow maize and yams to feed their families



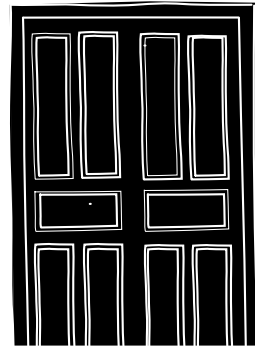
Many insects are very good to eat and very nutritious



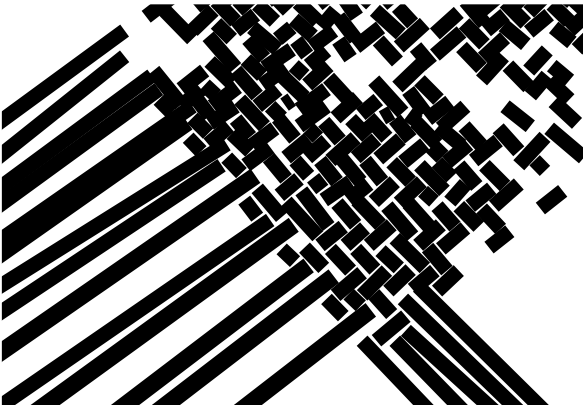
Some forest animals such as the bongo are hunted for meat



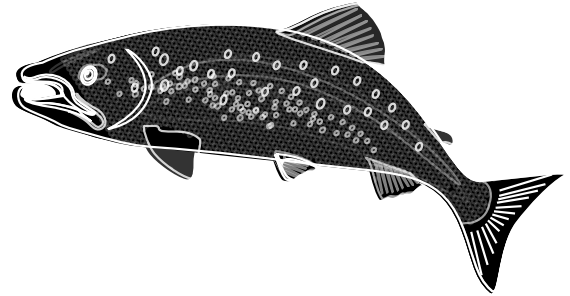
People make dug-out canoes from tree trunks
